Seva Canada's mission is to restore sight and prevent blindness in the developing world.


Our guiding principles


Our work

For three decades, Seva Canada has been helping communities develop their own capacity to deliver affordable eye care services.

Seva provides funding and expertise to partners in some of the poorest and most neglected countries and regions: Nepal, Tibet, India, Tanzania, Cambodia, Guatemala, Malawi, Madagascar and Egypt. Seva trains local eye specialists and builds sustainable eye care programs to deliver community and clinical eye care that reach the most vulnerable populations - children, women, the very poor and those living in rural areas.

In the past year alone, Seva and its partners performed over 500,000 eye surgeries and screened three million people for eye health.





The need

Blindness and low vision are major global health problems.

- Approximately 314 million people worldwide live with low vision and blindness.
- Of these, 45 million people are blind.
- Every 5 seconds a person in the world goes blind.
- A child goes blind every minute.
- 90% of the world's blind people live in developing countries.
- Two out of three blind people in the world are women, yet are the least likely to obtain sight-restoring services.
- Three-quarters of global blindness is treatable or preventable.
- Half of the world's blindness is caused by cataracts. In most cases, sight can be restored with a 15-minute surgery costing \$50 or less.



Your loved ones come first

Your loved ones come first. Your Will allows you to take care of your loved ones, after you are gone. But you can also use your Will to give the gift of sight and new hope for some of the world's poorest citizens. You may feel that once you've made provision for the people you love, there will be nothing left of value. But in fact, a small percentage of what's left can go a long way to help blind children, women and men see again.



What your legacy can do

\$1,000 will screen 2,000 children for eye problems and provide prescription glasses for those who need them.

\$5,000 will restore sight to 100 blind people through cataract surgery and change their lives forever.

\$15,000 will fund an eye camp in a remote area of Tibet at which 300-400 people will have their sight restored through cataract surgery.

\$25,000 will establish a Primary Eye Centre in a remote district of western Nepal where there is currently no eye care.

\$50,000 will fund 125 screening and treatment sites in Africa where patients have their eyes examined, are given glasses and referred for further care.

\$150,000 will fund a childhood blindness program in eastern Africa.

\$500,000 will ensure that 7,500 people have their sight restored, as well as train 10 doctors and provide equipment for vision centres.



A gift in your will

Leaving a bequest to Seva Canada Society in your Will is the simplest way to leave a legacy of sight.
